



CADORA BC Awards Programme

*To encourage riders in the training and schooling of their horses.
To promote and encourage Dressage riders resident in BC
To encourage a progressive approach to Dressage*

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Riders and owners must provide photocopy of HCBC and Cadora BC membership.
2. Senior and Junior members are eligible.
3. Only scores from Provincial shows (Horse Council BC Primary Competition – schooling or PaRC) **ONLY TESTS RIDDEN IN FRONT OF APPROVED HCBC OR EC JUDGES WILL BE ELIGIBLE**
4. Each horse/rider combination must compete in the same class level in a minimum of THREE competitions in one season. **No carry-over of scores from one year to another.**
5. 1st and 2nd placings will be awarded at each class level. **Additional placings may be awarded based on number of eligible competitors (min. 5) at each level.**
6. Award winners will be decided by **totalling the four highest scores received by each horse/rider combination in eligible dressage competitions during the season.**
7. A minimum score of **60%**(Training level – **55%**)is necessary to be eligible for an award.
8. Freestyles: **each horse/rider combination must compete at the same level in a minimum of two freestyle competitions in a season.**
9. **Horse/rider combination may receive only one award for each level.**
10. **The deadline for payment of registration fee is June 1st and for submission of tests is September 30th.**

AWARDS

Technical test: to the rider a certificate and for the horse/pony a plaque.

Freestyles: the top three competitors at each level will be presented a medal and the highest scoring freestyle will be awarded a prize of Cadora BC Saddle Pad

Technical Awards:

Training Level

Four scores of 55% or better.

First Level

Four scores of 60% or better.

Second Level

Four scores of 60% or better.

Third Level

Four scores of 60% or better.

Fourth Level

Four scores of 60% or better.

All FEI Levels

Four scores of 60% or better.

Freestyle Awards:

First Level

Two scores of 60% or better.

Second Level

Two scores of 60% or better.

Third Level

Two scores of 60% or better.

Fourth Level

Two scores of 60% or better.

All FEI Levels

Two scores of 60% or better.
