



CADORA BC Scholarship Program

- Purpose:** The CADORA BC Scholarship Fund was established on November 4th 1997 to assist athletes, **both grassroots and elite**, with their training expenses in dressage.
- The Fund:** The Scholarship Fund at present consists of CAD\$8838.48. Each year the total sum available for disbursement is limited to a total of 10% of the principal amount of the fund balance as of August 31st of the current fiscal year.
- Committee:** The CADORA BC Scholarship Fund committee, consisting of the President of Cadora BC and three others appointed by the president each year, accepts applications for funding up to August 15th of each year. The committee reviews applications and makes recommendations to the Cadora BC Board of Directors by September 15th of each year. The committee must advertise the existence of the Fund. An application form will be published in each group's newsletter.
- Eligibility:** Athletes must qualify for a scholarship. **Any BC dressage rider, who meets the following criteria, may apply.** Criteria include:
- Must be a CADORA BC member.
 - Must be a Canadian citizen (or landed immigrant).
 - Must be competing at Provincial, National or International competitions.
 - Priority will be given to applicants who have not yet received funding.
- Funding:**
- 1) An athlete may request assistance with costs incurred as a national or international competitor, in which case a point system will apply:
- Olympic Games, WEG & PanAm Games = 7 points each
 - Regional (Selection) Trials = 5 points
 - CDI @ FEI levels = 3 points
 - FEI levels @ recognised Canadian (National) or international competitions = 2 points
 - Non-FEI levels @ national competitions or PaRC = 1 point
- The athlete must apply in writing for a scholarship, showing evidence of scores, and give reasons why she/he deserves assistance. The candidate must submit costs **incurred** for the training expenses. The successful candidate must give a brief summary of her/his achievements and learning experiences.
- 2) An athlete may request assistance with costs incurred for a dressage oriented educational opportunity in Canada or abroad
- The athlete must apply in writing for a scholarship, showing evidence of scores, and give reasons why she/he deserves assistance. The candidate must submit **projected** costs for the training expenses. The successful candidate must account for expenditures at the end of the event for which she/he received assistance and give a brief summary of her/his achievements and learning experiences.
- Review:** These criteria are to be reviewed every three years. Latest revision: June 18, 2007.
